**WINEMAKER:** Michael Schreurs  
**VINTAGE:** Slightly warmer than average however consistently cool nights, compressed harvest window  
**ALCOHOL:** 13.5%  
**TOTAL ACIDITY:** 5.67 grams/litre  
**pH:** 3.52  
**COLOUR:** Deep Garnett  
**BOUQUET:** Concentrated, satsuma plum, mulberry, forest fruits  
**PALATE:** Soft with juicy plums, cherries, provincial herbs and velvety fine tannins  
**ALTITUDE:** 450m above sea level  
**CLONE:** DV115  
**ASPECT:** North Facing  
**SOIL:** Ancient lithosol over red podzolic clay
